RESOLUTION NO. 382-S-2001

WHEREAS, Article 62 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Local Government Code of 1991 mandates local government units or LGU's to promote the establishment and operation of people's organizations, Non-Governmental Organization (NGO's) and the private sector in the pursuit of local autonomy;

WHEREAS, a number of people's organizations and non-governmental organizations seek accreditation from legislative bodies of local government units in the Province of Cavite;

WHEREAS, in order to promote uniformity and consistency in the accreditation process, it is imperative that the province sets a policy and ordinance be passed to that effect;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan of the Province of Cavite in a session assembled to enact an ordinance, to wit:

Be it enacted by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan that :

ARTICLE I. TITLE

SECTION 1. This ordinance shall be known and cited as "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE ACCREDITATION OF PEOPLE'S ORGANIZATIONS, NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR IN THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE";

ARTICLE II. DEFINITION OF TERMS

SECTION 2. – Peoples organizations are civil society organizations such as civic groups, professionals and related associations with its own objectives other than assisting the government in the delivery of basic service to the people.

- Non-government organization are organizations whose primary objective is to assist the government in the delivery of basic services to the people.

- Private sector are organizations such as the Philippine Chamber of Commerce and Industry or their local chamber and affiliates which are not directly classified as people's organizations or non-governmental organizations.

ARTICLE III. GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 3. People's organizations, non-governmental organizations (NGOs) and private sector concerned whose operations and activities are limited within a city or municipality may apply for accreditation with the Sanggunians concerned of the respective municipalities or cities. The accreditation made by the Sangguniang Bayan or Panglungsod is subject to review and approval by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

SECTION 4. The Sangguniang Bayan and Sangguniang Panglungsod of all component municipalities and cities of the province are hereby enjoined to set their own policies, by way of ordinances, in the accreditation of people's organizations, non-governmental organization (NGOs) and private sector concerned. The ordinances to be enacted, by the component Sanggunians shall be consistent with this Ordinance and shall meet the minimum requirements and criteria set herein.

SECTION 5. The application shall include a duly approved board resolution of the people's organizations, non-governmental organization (NGOs) and private sector concerned, certificate of registration, list of officers, accomplishments and financial data of the organization.

SECTION 6. The Sanggunians concerned shall accredit the organizations based on the following criteria:

a.) Registration with either the Securities and Exchange Commission,

- b.) Organization's purpose and objectives such as community organization and development, livelihood development, capability building and similar developmental objectives and considerations;
- c.) Community-based with project development and implementation track record of at least one (1) year;
- d.) Reliability as evidenced by the preparation of annual reports and conduct of annual meetings duly certified by the board secretary of the organization; and
- e.) In case of PBACs, the organization or any of its members shall have no conflict of interest in the awarding of infrastructure or other projects.

SECTION 7. For organizations applying for accreditation with the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, the applicants shall pay an application fee amounting to One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00). For organizations which have applied for accreditation with the Sangguniang Panglungsod or Bayan, no other fee shall be charged by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan.

ARTICLE IV. REGULATORY PROVISIONS

SECTION 8. The accreditation shall be valid for a period of one-year with yearly renewal. Renewal shall be granted upon presentation of list of officers, annual financial statement and a description of the on-year operation of the organizations concerned.

SECTION 9. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after the required posting and publication.
