**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE HON. JUANITO VICTOR C. REMULLA, JR., PROVINCIAL GOVERNOR, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF CAVITE, TO ENTER INTO AND SIGN A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT (MOA) WITH THE NATIONAL HOUSING AUTHORITY (NHA) AND LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT AUTHORITY (LRTA) FOR THE TURNOVER OF THE LRTA RELOCATION SITE BY THE PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OF CAVITE TO THE NHA AND/OR LRTA FOR THE CONTINUATION OF THE AFOREMENTIONED HOUSING PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, presented to the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan for review and consideration is a letter from Hon. Juanito Victor C. Remulla, Jr., Provincial Governor, requesting for authority to enter into and sign a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) with the National Housing Authority (NHA) and the Light Rail Transit Authority (LRTA) for the turnover of the LRTA relocation site by the Provincial Government of Cavite to the NHA and /or LRTA for the aforementioned housing project;

**WHEREAS**, on March 03, 2008, during its 7<sup>th</sup> Regular Session, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan approved Resolution No. 079-S-2008, authorizing the Provincial Governor, Hon. Ayong S. Maliksi, to enter into a Memorandum Of Agreement for and on behalf of the Province of Cavite with LRTA for LRT extension project and relocation facilities;
