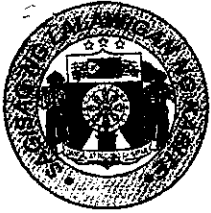

**WHEREAS**, drug related crimes at street level may seem more apparent threat to our safety, but it is the steady enlargement of power of big time criminal organizations who feed for growth on drug trafficking that is the main threat of our time;

**WHEREAS**, on 17 May 2016, elements of Bacoor CPS led by Police Inspector Lito Maniwang Ginawa, under the supervision of Supt. Ronan Rodriguez Claravall, arrested three men and a teenager who yielded Php10,000,000.00 worth of methamphetamine hydrochloride or "shabu", following a buy-bust operation inside Park Homes Subdivision, Queens Row West, Bacoor City;

**WHEREAS**, on a joint buy-bust operation conducted by the Cavite Police Provincial Office Anti-Illegal Drugs Group (AIDG) and the Imus City Police on 20 May 2016, resulted in the arrest of an alleged drug pusher and the confiscation of 29 kilos or an estimated P14 million worth of shabu;

**WHEREAS**, the success in the efforts of our police forces in curbing illicit drug trafficking is a significant achievement as we continue to wage war against drugs and its effect on the province.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Gawaran, duly seconded by Hon. Mangubat and all the members present, be it

**RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that Police Superintendent Ronan Rodriguez Claravall, Police Inspector Lito Maniwang Ginawa and the Cavite Police Provincial Office, be commended for their valiant efforts in curtailing illegal drugs in the province.
