**A RESOLUTION REVIVING THE CAVITE RECLAMATION PROJECT-SPECIAL ECONOMIC ZONE FOR THE CONTINUOUS PROGRESS OF THE PROVINCE**

**WHEREAS**, presented to the Honorable Members of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan, for review and consideration, is Joint Committee Report No. 111, submitted by Hon. Kerby J. Salazar, Chairman, Committee on Rules and Good Government, and Hon. Homer T. Saquilayan, Vice Chairman, Committee on Public Works and Infrastructures, pertaining to the request of Hon. Jesus Crispin C. Remulla, Provincial Governor, to revive the Cavite Reclamation Project-Special Economic Zone;

**WHEREAS**, upon careful review and deliberation of both committees during its joint committee meeting on 25 October 2016, it has been recommended that the request to revive the project be approved as it is seen essential for the continual development of the province;

**WHEREAS**, a Memorandum of Understanding was previously arranged between the Provincial Government of Cavite and the Philippine Reclamation Authority (PRA) regarding the Cavite Reclamation Project-Special Economic Zone – a seafront development involving the reclamation of 40-60 hectares of foreshore and offshore areas of the Bacoor Bay for tourism, commercial, recreational, banking, investment and establishment of financial centers;

**WHEREAS**, the project will entail reclamation of substantial portion of the Bacoor Bay situated at the southern portion of the Manila-Cavite Toll Expressway Extension and will provide peripheral canals/channels as waterway access to and from the Manila Bay and around the reclamation project;

**WHEREAS**, the Cavite Reclamation Project-Special Economic Zone was approved for implementation by the Provincial Government of Cavite under Resolution No. 89-S2008, dated March 1, 2008 and the Cavite Government has filed with PRA on April 23, 2008, its application for approval of the proposed reclamation project and submitted an initial concept of the Site Development Plan of the project;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, on motion of Hon. Salazar, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and all the members present, be it

**RESOLVED, AS IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED**, that the Cavite Reclamation Project-Special Economic Zone, be revived, for the continuous progress of the province.
