STRIKE B. REVILLA, REPRESENTATIVE OF THE 2ND DISTRICT OF CAVITE

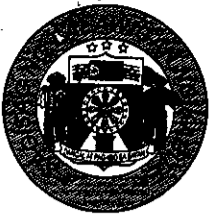
WHEREAS, the cities of Bacoor and Dasmariñas are considered as two of the most progressive and highly urbanized cities in the Province of Cavite;

WHEREAS, these suburban cities where commercial establishments, famous landmarks, key institutions are located is within reach and is accessible through major thoroughfares such as CAVITEX, Molino Boulevard, Daang ~~West~~, Marcos Alvarez Avenue and Aguinaldo Highway;

WHEREAS, traversing the eastern part of Bacoor City is Molino Boulevard, a stretch of 7.1 km. national road which serves as the main passageway connecting Bacoor northward to Manila and westward to Alabang;

WHEREAS, considering that the said boulevard is within the territorial jurisdiction of the City of Bacoor, renaming it from Molino Boulevard to Bacoor Boulevard is deemed more appropriate;

WHEREAS, the Molino-Salawag-Paliparan Road on the other hand, a road stretching from the Cities of Bacoor to Dasmariñas, has become one of the major thoroughfares connecting both Cities and serving thousands of motorists and commuters every day;

WHEREAS, the name of the said highway has often been confused with Molino Boulevard as well as the existing Molino Road in the City of Bacoor, hence the very need to rename the said route to Bacoor-Dasmariñas Road to avoid confusion;

WHEREAS, the successful passage of House Bill No. 4189 and House Bill No. 4190 would further recognize the invaluable contribution of these major thoroughfares in boosting tourism and providing economic growth in the Province.


