PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2013-023

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2012-025 KNOWN AS "CREATION OF BARANGAY POPULATION INFORMATION DESK AND APPOINTING A BARANGAY PERSONNEL ASSIGNED THEREOF"

(Sponsored by: Hon. Irene De Padua Bencito)

WHEREAS, Article IX, Section 37 of R.A. 7279 known as Urban Development and Housing Act of 1992, provides that local government unit shall set up an effective mechanism, together with the appropriate agency like the Commission on Population, the National Economic and Development Authority and the National Statistic Office to monitor trends in the movements of population from rural to urban, urban to urban, and urban to rural areas;

WHEREAS, Provincial Ordinance No. 2012-25 was enacted on the 98th Regular Session of the Sangguniang Panlalawigan on September 24, 2012;

WHEREAS, there is need to amend certain provisions of the said ordinance in order to improve the consolidation and generation of population data in every barangay;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 468 of R.A. 7160, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan as the legislative body of the province shall enact ordinances, approved resolutions and appropriate funds for the general welfare of the province;

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Irene P. Benito, duly seconded by Hon. Gawaran and all the members present, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session duly assembled that:

Section 1. This ordinance shall be known as "**Ordinance for the creation of Barangay Migration Council and Information Center**".

Section 2. MANDATE AND SCOPE - Under the direction of the Barangay Chairman, the Barangay Migration Information Officer is mandated to establish and maintain an updated, accurate and reliable data of all inhabitants of the Barangay in aid of development planning and implementation of government programs and projects towards the attainment of sustainable human development; closely coordinate and cooperate with both government and non-government partners in providing access and delivery of basic services to population development, and serve as migration center which monitor population movement and assists migrants and transient in their socio-cultural and economic adjustment within the barangay.

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS

- a) Transients – residents who are in the Barangay from 0 to 6 months continuously
- b) Migrants – residents who are in the Barangay from 6 months to 2 years continuously
- c) CBMS – Community Base Monitoring System
- d) Center – serve as migration center which monitors, population movements within the barangay
- e) Population Migration Information Officer- the Barangay Secretary
- f) Barangay Population Worker – focal person, appointed by the Barangay Chairman,
- g) Survey enumerator – existing barangay personnel
- h) Migration – the movement of people across a specific boundary for the purpose of establishing a new permanent residence or semi permanent residency
- i) Urban – a barangay with a population of 500 or more has at least 1 medium or 1 large establishment or has 5 or more small establishments and 5 more facilities

The Barangay Migration Information Center shall have the following personnel;

- a. Barangay Migration Information Officer – the Barangay Chairman shall designate the Barangay Secretary as the Barangay Migration Information Officer.
- b. Barangay Population Worker – the Barangay Chairman shall appoint a barangay population worker who shall act as the focal person in the planning, implementation and monitoring of population development, including migration programs and projects.
- c. Survey Enumerators – existing barangay government personnel shall be tapped to serve as survey enumerators.

Section 5. FUNCTIONS

5.1 Barangay Migration Information Officer

- a. To keep an updated record of all inhabitants of the Barangay containing pertinent information and such maybe prescribed by law or ordinance.
- b. He/She shall also submit a report on actual number of barangay residents as often as may be required by the sangguniang barangay.

5.2 Barangay Population Workers

The Barangay Population Workers shall take charge of the following duties and responsibilities:

- a. Assists the Municipal Population Program workers in the conduct of community seminars/assemblies,
- b. Participate in the conduct of surveys at the barangay coverage in order to generate relevant up to date and reliable population data statistics.
- c. Perform other population development and responsible parenthood related activities such as, but not limited to motivation and referral of patients to clinics and hospitals for family planning, survey of married of reproductive age and massive IEC campaign,
- d. Collaborate with other barangay staff and workers in carrying out income generating projects.
- e. Participate in the organization of youth and parents, and
- f. Perform such other functions as maybe assigned by the Barangay Chairman and/or Sangguniang Barangay.

5.3 Survey Enumerators

Survey enumerators shall take charge of the actual conduct of house to house survey within the barangay.

Section 6. FUNDING - The Cost of establishment and operations of the Barangay Migration Council and Information Center shall be allocated from the annual budgets of the barangay to support the planning, implementation, monitoring and evaluation.

Section 7. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE - If any part of this ordinance is declared unconstitutional or unlawful, such declaration shall not affect the other parts or sections hereof are not declared unlawful or unconstitutional.

Section 8. REPEALING CLAUSE - All previous ordinance is inconsistent with this ordinance shall be deemed modified accordingly.

Section 9. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE - This ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days after its publication in a new newspaper of local circulation or after posting in three conspicuous in the province.
