PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 067

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING SMART COMMUNICATIONS INCORPORATED FROM THE PAYMENT OF REAL PROPERTY TAXES ON ALL MACHINERIES/EQUIPMENT

Sponsored by: Hon. Ives Jayne A. Reyes
Co-sponsored by: All SP Members

WHEREAS, Section 232 of Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991 provides that all real property, such as land, building, machinery, and other improvements are subject to real property tax;

WHEREAS, Section 192 of the same Act authorizes the local government units to grant tax exemptions, incentives or reliefs, under such terms and conditions that may deem are necessary;

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Local Government Finance, as the oversight arm of the Department of Finance, issued BLGF Memorandum Circular No. 01-2010 dated January 13, 2010 which granted exemption to Globe and other telecommunication companies;

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WHEREAS, the Sangguniang Panlalawigan supports the Provincial Government in maintaining Cavite as an investor-friendly province and in forging strong partnership with the private sector in the pursuit of sustainable development;

NOW THEREFORE, on motion of Hon. Reyes, duly seconded by Hon. Lara and all the members present, be it ordained by the Sangguniang Panlalawigan in session duly assembled that:

Section 1. Title. This Ordinance shall be known and cited as *"An Ordinance Exempting the SMART Communications, Inc. From Payment of all Real Property Taxes on All Machineries/Equipment"*

Section 2. Declaration of Policy. It is hereby declared the policy of the Provincial Government of Cavite to continuously recognize the essential role that the private sector plays in attaining sustainable development in the province.

Section 3. Definition of Terms. The following terms as used in its Ordinance shall mean:

- a. *Machinery/Equipment* – machinery actually, directly and exclusively used in the operation of Smart Communications Inc.
- b. *Real Property Tax* – tax imposed on lands, buildings, towers and improvements of Smart Communications Inc.
- c. *Real Property Tax Exemption* – privilege given to Smart Communications Inc. for its machinery/equipment which are actually, directly, and exclusively used in the operation of its franchise
- d. *Regulatory Fees* – fees other than real property tax due to Smart Communications Inc.

Section 4. Scope. The Smart Communications, Inc. (SMART) is hereby given tax exemption from the payment of real property tax on all machineries/equipment.

Regulatory fees and other taxes not expressly mentioned in the next preceding paragraph are not covered by this Ordinance.

Section 5. Separability Clause. If, for any reason or reasons, any provision of this Ordinance shall be held unconstitutional or invalid, the other provisions not affected thereby shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 6. Effectivity. This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval.
