RESOLUTION NO. 255-S-2007

WHEREAS, as provided for in Republic Act No. 7160, otherwise known as the Local Government Code of 1991, every local government unit shall exercise powers and discharge functions that will ensure the health and safety of its constituents;

WHEREAS, pursuant to this, the Provincial Government of Cavite shall institute measures to solve health problems and to provide basic services and facilities concerning the prevention and control of animal pests and diseases;

WHEREAS, relevant to this, the Province envisioned to maintain its status as an FMD and Bird Flu Free Province by preventing the entry of livestock, poultry and other zoonotic diseases and ensuring that meat and other meat products are safe for the consuming public;

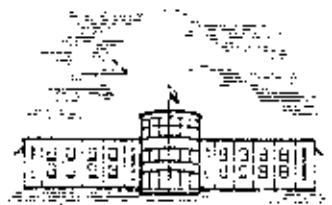
WHEREFORE, there is a need to regulate the movement and transport of animals within the territorial jurisdiction of the province and to impose the corresponding fees thereof;

PROVINCIAL ORDINANCE NO. 2007-004

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING ANIMAL QUARANTINE CHECKPOINTS FOR FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE (FMD) AND OTHER ZOOONOTIC DISEASES AT STRATEGIC ENTRY POINTS IN THE PROVINCE OF CAVITE AND IMPOSING FEES THEREOF

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This ordinance shall be known and cited as the "Animal Quarantine Checkpoints Ordinance."

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY. It is the policy of the Provincial Government of Cavite that the Caviteños are protected from any harmful disease thereby ensuring their health and safety.

SECTION 3. CREATION. There is hereby established animal quarantine checkpoints at strategic entry points in the Province of Cavite specifically in the following areas:

- a. Brgy. Amuyong, Alfonso, Cavite;
- b. Brgy. Maduya, Carmona, Cavite;
- c. Brgy. Talaba, Bacoor, Cavite;
- d. Daang Hari, Bacoor, Cavite;
- e. Sta. Rosa Exit, Tagaytay City, Cavite;
- f. Zapote Road, Bacoor, Cavite;
- g. Talisay, Tagaytay City, Cavite;
- h. Other future entry points.

SECTION 4. FEES. The following fees are hereby imposed:

A. **Inspection Fee.** For Incoming and Outgoing Livestock and Poultry within the Province:

Carabao	-	P 40.00/head
Cattle and Horse	-	P 30.00/head
Sheep, Goat and Swine	-	P 6.00/head
Fighting Cock	-	P 100.00/head
Full Grown Chicken	-	P 0.10/head
Day Old Chicks	-	P 0.10/head
Domestic Pets	-	P 50.00/head
Other Animals	-	P 50.00/head

B. **Disinfection Fee.** For All Livestock/Transport Carriers Coming In and Out of the Province:

Tricycle	-	P 10.00/vehicle
Jeep/Trailers/Vans	-	P 20.00/vehicle
6 Wheel Truck	-	P 30.00/vehicle
8-10 Wheel Truck	-	P 50.00/vehicle

SECTION 5. IMPLEMENTING AGENCY. The Provincial Treasurer or his duly authorized representative/s, in cooperation with the Provincial Veterinarian, is hereby authorized/deputized to collect fees.

The said offices are hereby directed to promulgate rules and regulations for the effective implementation of this ordinance.

SECTION 6. SUBMISSION OF REPORT. The Provincial Treasurer shall submit a monthly report of fees collected from the said project to the Office of the Governor.

SECTION 7. APPROPRIATION. An amount of Nine Hundred Thousand Pesos (P 900,000.00) is hereby initially appropriated for the operation of the identified animal quarantine checkpoints.

SECTION 8. PENALTY. Any violation of this Ordinance shall be subject to a confiscation of the subject animal and carrier and a fine of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00).

SECTION 9. EFFECTIVITY. This Ordinance shall take effect after its approval.
