**BAC-A RESOLUTION NO. 120-B SERIES OF 2020**

**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT UNDER  
EMERGENCY CASES FOR THE PURCHASE OF NON-CONTACT THERMAL SCANNER  
FOR USE OF KPFP DURING THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK**

**WHEREAS**, the Province of Cavite was declared to be under a "State of Calamity" due to the outbreak of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19), under Sangguniang Panlalawigan Resolution No. 1437-2020;

**WHEREAS**, under Proclamation No. 1021, the continuous rise in COVID-19 positive cases and deaths in the country despite efforts and interventions to contain the same prompted President Rodrigo R. Duterte to extend the period of the state of calamity throughout the Philippines for a period of one (1) year, effective 13 September 2020 to 12 September 2021, unless earlier lifted or extended as circumstances may warrant;

**WHEREAS**, the extension affords the National Government, as well as local government units (LGUs), ample latitude to continue utilizing appropriate funds in disaster preparedness and response efforts to contain the spread of COVID-19, monitor and control prices of basic necessities and prime commodities, and provide basic services to the affected populations;

**WHEREAS**, the Provincial Government of Cavite has allocated **Seventy-Eight Thousand Pesos (P78,000.00)** as Approved Budget for the Contract under PR No. 2020-9-H-378-A/9-14-20 for the purchase of non-contact thermal scanner for use of KPFP during the COVID-19 outbreak;

**WHEREAS**, under **Annex "H"** of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of the Republic Act 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Act," Negotiated Procurement under Emergency Cases may be resorted to:

- i. **"In case of imminent danger to life or property during a state of calamity"**

**WHEREAS**, **CSV ENTERPRISES**, a legally, technically, and financially capable supplier as evaluated, checked and verified by the Bids and Awards Committee Technical Working Group, with business address at **531 Bucandala, City of Imus, Cavite**, represented by **Ms. Carmencita S. Villaronte**, submitted quotation for the non-contact thermal scanner amounting to **Seventy-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Six Pesos (P77,976.00)**.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Bids and Awards Committee for Goods, Services, and Consultancy (BAC-A) **RESOLVES** as it is hereby **RESOLVED** to **RECOMMEND** Negotiated Procurement for Emergency Cases for the **PURCHASE OF NON-CONTACT THERMAL SCANNER FOR USE OF KPFP DURING THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK**.

**RESOLVED FURTHER** to recommend the **AWARD** to and **CONTRACT** with **CSV ENTERPRISES** for the **PURCHASE OF NON-CONTACT THERMAL SCANNER FOR USE OF KPFP DURING THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK** in the amount of **Seventy-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Seventy-Six Pesos (P77,976.00)**.

**RESOLVED FINALLY** that copies of the resolution be submitted to all concerned for their appropriate action.
